'You are welcome, gentlemen. Come, musicians, play.'	Lord Capulet	He is a good host. He wants all his guests to enjoy the party.
'Did my heart love till now? Forswear it, sight!/ For I ne'er saw true beauty till this night.'		
Now, by the stock and honour of my kin, To strike him dead I hold it not a sin.'		
'Be quiet, or-More light, more light!- For shame!/ I'll make you quiet, what!- Cheerly, my hearts!'		
'I will withdraw. But this intrusion shall, Now seeming sweet, convert to bitterest gall.'
