Attached are some frames for you to use or adapt for timed essay practice with Year 11 examination groups.

The proposed guidelines are as follows

Use them as the focus for an entire lesson:

- 1. Essay question on board
- 2. Highlight key words
- 3. Look at poem and discuss/check notes in Anthology
- 4. Discuss and complete frame
- 5. Into exam conditions
- 6. Use frame to answer question in 30 mins
- 7. Collect papers

WARNING

Don't use <u>all</u> of them! They <u>are</u> similar and could easily become boring. However their similarity of structure should provide a memorable and useful framework for examination writing.

Please note that mark schemes have NOT been provided. The questions are based on NEAB Sample Material and the Heinemann Working with the English Anthology textbook, along with a few of my own ideas. Mark schemes or marking ideas are available in these publications.
